# Housing Resources & Coordinated Entry Locations

Individuals facing homelessness in Maricopa County can access housing resources at these **Coordinated Entry** locations:

## What to expect at an entry point:

- 1. Interview:** Information about your situation will be gathered so that you are connected with appropriate services.
- 2. Resource Connection:** Based on your specific situation, you will be provided with resources that fit your need.
- 3. Housing Plan:** Shelter options and a housing plan will be discussed

## Key items needed for housing:

- Proof of income/job history
- 2 valid forms of identification (state ID, Birth Certificate, Social Security)
- Government benefits such as SNAP, AHCCCS and/or Medicare
- Phone number
